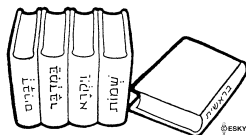

Parashas Zachor

It is a positive mitzvah to erase the memory of Amalek and a further positive mitzvah to always remember their evil deeds. Our Rabbis derive that Amalek's treachery must be recalled orally, and not be forgotten from the heart, for it is Forbidden to forget their hatred and enmity. Haman was a descendant of Amalek. That is why we read this extra Torah portion today (Devarim 25: 17-19) on the Shabbos before Purim so that the 'wiping-out' of Amalek might be adjacent to the 'wiping-out' of Haman.
